Recent Advances in Stochastic Systems Theory and Its Applications

Papers are invited on general topics in this field, including (but not limited to) analysis of stochastic processes and stochastic systems, state estimation and control of stochastic systems, system identification and parameter estimation, signal processing and spectral estimation, image processing and pattern recognition, applications in engineering, chaos and fractal, neural networks and fuzzy systems, stochastic approaches in medical and biomedical systems, and mathematical finance, etc.

Manuscript Styles: The manuscript should be prepared as single-column and double spacing. The paper should start with Title, Author name(s), Authors' affiliations and email addresses, the name of corresponding author, Abstract, Keywords, main body, Acknowledgements, and References.
